



The **Securing Communities Against Hate Crimes (SCAHC) Grant** can be applied to the following security items:

Facility Hardening Costs

- Perimeter lighting
- Alarm systems
- Camera-based security systems
- Access control systems
- Perimeter fencing, barriers, bollards
- Blast resistant film for windows and/or shatter resistant windows
- Interior and exterior doors and hardening/locking mechanisms
- Panic Button/Lock-Down systems
- Public Address (PA) systems
- Impact protection

Security Training Costs

- Attendance/registration fees for training
- Costs for training materials and supplies
- Travel related costs to attend training

Cybersecurity Project Costs

- Costs associated with the development of cybersecurity plans, including the contracting of consultants to identify potential vulnerabilities and develop risk plans
- Software packages including firewalls, anti-virus applications, and malware protection
- Network equipment including servers
- Encryption software
- Intrusion detection systems
- Hardware components that provide protection against cyber threats

Please note that the SCAHC grant may **not** be used to hire security guards or other safety personnel, support the maintenance or routine use of existing systems, or fund any project that has previously received SCAHC grant funding.
